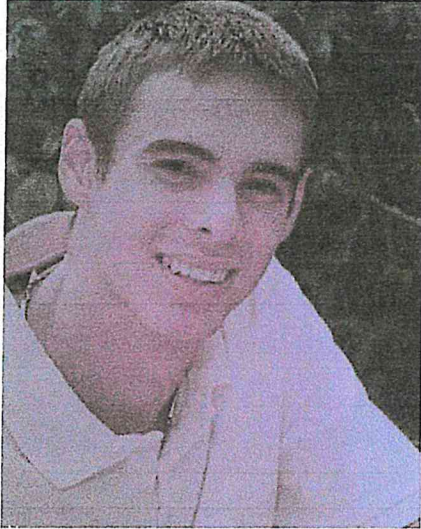


Dakota Cheyenne Sinclair Memorial Scholarship
